## 1. Create a CollegeBoard Account

You will use your CollegeBoard account to sign in to Bluebook, the official online practice test application. If you already have a CollegeBoard account for SAT or AP registration, you can skip this step!

Go to www.collegeboard.org and click Create Account → Student.

- Fill out your personal information on each page. Prompts with an asterisk\* are required.
- You may need to verify details like your name, email address, and password.

Success! Your CollegeBoard account has been created.
